



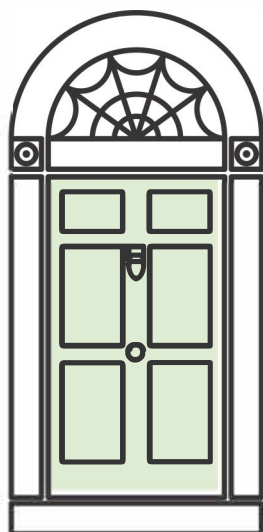

A beginner's guide to architecture

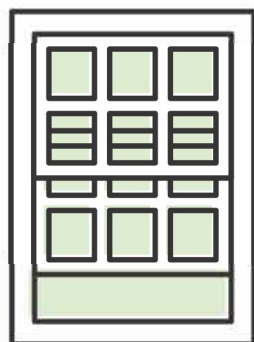

of glass**

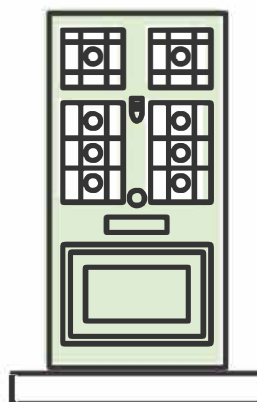


Sash window:

up and down to open

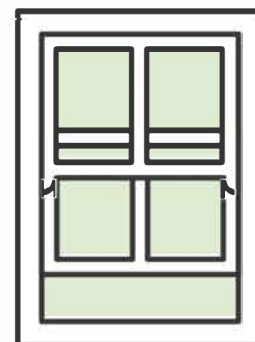
Victorian 1837–1901

in the door**



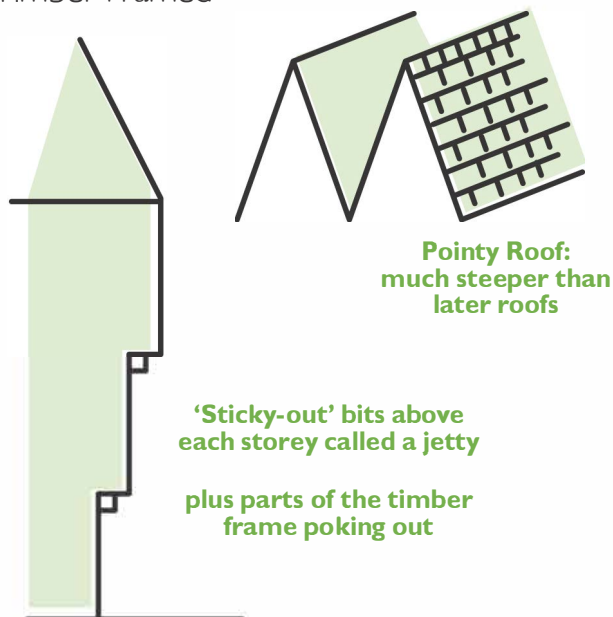
**Bigger panes
