Heritage is an important source of economic prosperity and growth with a large number of economic activities occurring within it, dependent on it or attracted to it.

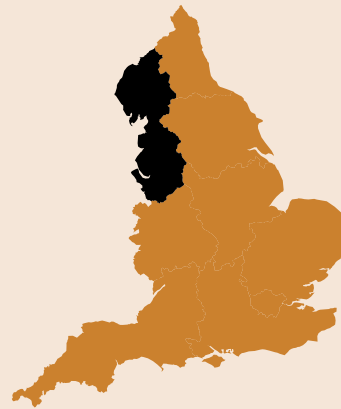

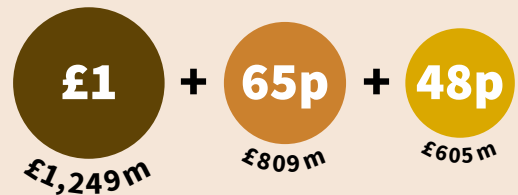


For every £1 of GVA directly generated, an additional £1.13 of GVA is supported in the wider economy

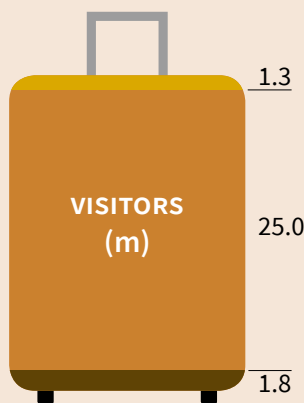

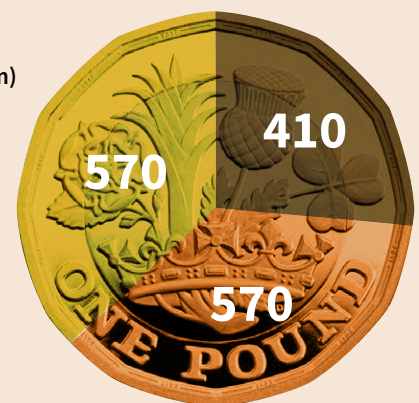
