

WEST STOW: HUMAN BONE REPORT GUY GRANGER

The remains examined consisted mainly of human infant bones, with a few adult fragments. All the infant bones were of individuals less than one year old, most apparently new born. At least thirteen infants are represented, this being the number of right femurs seen in the sample.
