The leather was identified from grain patterns where these were distinctive (LCC, 1981, 9-11; Reed, 1972, 25, 283-5). Leather was regarded as mature cattle hide if it was 4mm thick upwards. (LCC 1981, 4,5; Reed 1972, 285).

Many of the soles were worn, although seven did have a small area of grain pattern. Using the thickness as a guide most of them were found to be cattle hide. The reconstructed shoes caused a problem as it was impossible to measure the thickness of the soles, so these and some of the more worn examples have been described as calf/cattle as the original thickness is no longer clear. One sole was particularly thin (10.SH 74 [467] <166>) and has a grain pattern which suggested it was sheep/goat rather than calf, although both it and the associated upper were very worn.

Three pieces of upper were so worn as to have no surface with a grain pattern remaining,(22.SWA 81 [2078] <4649>; BWB 82 [161] <53>; BC 72 [55] <1669>). The uppers vary between calf and sheep/goat. No distinction has been made between sheep/goat and deer (Reed 1972, 285). Some of those described as sheep/goat may have been deer skin, but we are not yet certain of the diagnostic pattern for the latter. Two pieces of upper were thick and were possibly cattle rather than calf,(38. BC 72 [250] <4039>; BWB 83 [120] <54>).
