Fifty nine fragments or complete bones were collected and four marine shells. These are tabulated below as determined :

The finds warrant little discussion . Among the sheep (or goat) bones two were from juvenile animals and one of the ox bones also. One bone only bore the marks of butchery . The sheep bones are of a size consistent with post-Mediaeval material being somewhat larger and more robust than the typical Mediaeval sheep found in Newcastle .
