


CHALK LANE, Northampton.

10 stone samples from John Williams via Leo Biek 30/11/79.

- Specimen 794848 - Late Saxon quern fragment- Niedermendig Basalt.
794849 - " " " " - Niedermendig Basalt.
794850 - Late Saxon-Saxo-Norman, ? Quern fragt- Dark brown
ferruginous sandstone from Northampton Sands (local
Inferior Oolite).
794851 - ?Late Saxon- Mica schist from Glacial Drift.
794852 - Late Saxon quern fragments- Niedermendig Basalt.
794853 - Late Saxon ?quern fragment- this is a pink biotite
granite from the Glacial Drift. It shows no signs of
wear and is not likely to have been a quern.
794854 - Architectural fragment. Pale-brown, fine-grained sandstone
probably from the Northampton Sands.
794855 - Early/Middle Saxon, ?quern fragment - brown micaceous
sandstone with black iron spots probably from the
local Northampton Sands. Probably not a quern, the flat
surface looks like a bedding plane.
794856 - Late Saxon ?quern fragment- is a brown sandstone like
794855 i.e. Northampton Sands. Shows definite signs of
wear.
794857 - ?Late Saxon - Mica schist from the Glacial Drift cf.
794851.
