## Charcoal samples from Mountgrace Priory

The samples consisted of very large fragments of charcoal collected by the excavator, and may therefore present a biased picture in some respects. The identifications for each sample are given below. A fairly large proprtion of the material was from twigs or branches (for convenience, twig is defined as up to 5cm diameter, and branch as larger but with curvature still present on the growth rings).
