H.2. Jug handle, c.1530 A.D.

Impression of fine textiles, traces over the top and one side of the handle, with a clear area measuring c.1.5 X 0.7 cm.

Spinning Z both systems, variable, weave tabby (plain), regular, count 15/16 threads per cm, the weft taken as 8 threads on 5 mm.

The appearance suggests a flax cloth, perhaps used in lifting the jug before it was baked.
