Alley applied presch (Lap.ne.12032)

On back, along and under pin, area of ?leather or skin; under this, on pin, with root fibres, deteriorated area of textile, 2.5 X 0.8 cm, flattened surface, Z spinning, probably fine tabby weave.

Pair to above (Lab.ne.12033)

A/gain on pin and attachment, and detached fragments, deteriorated fragments Z threads visible, as on 12032.

47A. Burial 185

Disc broock (Lab.ne.8112026)

Deteriorated replaced threads, Z, on pin attachment.

Detacked, (a) Tragment textile, fibres replaced, spinning Z one system, S the other, weave probably tabby (plaim), but very deteriorated.

(b) fragment 0.8 X 0.6 cm, spinning Z both systems, weave tabby, one thread system fairly coarse, lightly spun, ?weft, the other almost kidden, finer and with tighter spin; count 7-8/7 t:reads on 5 mm.

The appearance of threads in (a) and (b) is very sidilar, apart from the spidning directions.

Pair to above (Lab.me.8112053)

Front, two small areas textile, 0.65 and 0.6 and 1.0 X 0.5 cm, probably flax, natural colour, Z spun noth systems, tabby weave, count 18/16(taken as 8 on 5 mm) threads per cm, fairly even spinning and weaving.

Back, ?bone replaced, under it replaced fairly coarse textile, Z,Z spinning, proken threads, but appearance suggests twill.

Fraguents pin (Lab. no. 8112035)

All along one side, deteriorated replaced textile; on the other, replaced tablet twists, 1/.2.0 cm, with c.7 mm, probably the border on a Z,Z spun tabby weave, count estimated c.20/18 threads per cm (5 on 2.5 mm/9 on 5 mm); border 4-hole tablet weave, 2 coarse twists lying S,Z, the rest confused, possibly all Z, or patterned weave, surface deteriorated.

(Lab.me.8112036)

On other fragment, probably same tabby weave, but lesser asson, count c.12/12 per cm, all over the length of the pin, 4.0 X c.1.2 cm, with tablet weave better preserved, showing c.8 twists on 5 mm, diagonal patterned weave, edge hidden by a fold of the tabby weave.

Pin from 12054 (Lab.mo.8112037)

Replaced Z, Sply threads going round pin, either to tie, or from fringe.

A few threads of fine weave, Z one system, and possible tablet weave remains above
