In middle of one side of blade, approx. 0.5 x 0.5cms of mineralised Z-spun threads, 0.6mm in diameter.

Bronze annular brooches

On upper(?) surface of outer brooch, crossing onto pin of inner brooch, 1.0 x 0.8cms of mineralised twill, probably 2/2; system 1: 10 threads per cm / Z-spin / 0.9mm diameter system 2: 9 " "/S-spin / 0.9mm"

Grave BlO4

Bronze annular brooch

On front of brooch and pin, in several folds, $2.5 \times 2.0 \text{cms}$ of tabby (plain weave):

system 1: 18-20 thr.p.cm / Z / 0.4mm system 2: 12-16 $^{"}$ / Z / 0.4mm

Fault: three system I threads run together at one point, due to missing threads which re-appear further on. Partially mineralised, but some intact fibres proved to be vegetable bast fibre, almost certainly flax.

Glass bead with green decoration and blue glass bead Inside both, a cabled cord, S-twisted from 2 x 2-ply threads, both S-plied from Z-spuns, a total of 1.5mm diameter. Fibres replaced.

Some replaced Z-twist threads, 0.6-0.7mm diameter, in area of iron corrosion.

GW bronze angular brooch

On front of brooch at hinge end of pin, 1.5 x 1.0 cms of mineralised 2/2 twill:

More ZZ threads on back of pin


Gilded bronze square-headed brooch (in two pieces)

On front of square head of brooch, 3.0 \times 2.0cms and 1.5 \times 1.5cms of tabby:

system 1: 12 thr.p.cm / Z / 0.6mm

system 2: 9 " / Z / 0.6mm

Vegetable bast fibre, not necessarily flax.

On back of brooch, 6.0 x 4.5cms and 1.0 x 0.8cms of replaced 2/2 twill, possibly a broken twill:

system 2: 8 " / S / 0.9mm

Unlabelled find 2

Bronze annular brooch

In association with broach, several folds of 2/2 broken diamond twill, touching the upper surface of the broach and enclosing several beads in the folds; total area 8.5×5.0 cms; fibre replaced.

system 1: 9 thr.p.cm / Z / 0.9mm

system 2:8 " / S / 1.1mm

1,5 x 0.5cms of similar ZS twill on pin.

Also on pin of brooch, 1.5 x 1.0cms of 2/2 twill, also replaced: system 1: 10 thr.p.cm / Z / C.6mm

system 2: 9 " / Z / 1.2mm

Bead (1) - millefiori

Through centre of bead, 2-ply thread, 2.0mm diameter, spin and twist not clear.

Bead (3) - amber

1.0 x0.5cms of replaced 2/2 twill:

Beads (4) and (5)

Threading both beads, 1. 2-ply cord, 2.0mm diameter, S-twisted from Z-spun wool(?), and a cord, possibly cabled from Z-spun threads, 1.5mm diameter. The plied cord is knotted twice on the outside of one of the beads.

Bead (6)

2 Z-spun threads, 1.0mm diameter.

Looping round pin from back of brooch, 3.5 x 2.0cms of ribbed

wool tabby: system 1: 12 thr.p.cm / Z / O.6mm

system 2: 6 " / S / C.8mm
