The Animal Bones From Gretton Northamptonshire

The animal bones from Gretton were looked at at the Ancient Monuments Laboratory Department of the Environment. The quantity of material presented was small (three half filled one hundred weight sacs, giving an estimated 500 fragment of bone). No attempt was made to record the animal bones since their quantity would not have produced a meaningful result. However by observation the following species were the only ones noted ; cattle (Bos sp. domestic), sheep/goat (Ovis/Capra sp.), pig (Sus sp. domestic).

Currently the material is stored by the Ancient Monuments Laboratory and may be traced through it a later date.
