Upper right canine tooth, worn and chipped.

819835 406  
Sheep (Ovis sp. domestic) or goat (Capra sp. domestic)  
fragment of proximal end of right ulna.

Hare (Lepus capensis)  
Left radius, lacking distal end. Proximal end fused.

Hare (Lepus capensis)  
Left ulna, lacking distal end. Proximal end fused. Apparently  
the same animal as the previous bone.

Goose (Anser sp. domestic)  
Right carpometacarpus  
L 81.9mm; g.b. prox. 19.0mm; max. width both shafts 9.9mm

Black Grouse (Lyrurus tetrix)  
Left tibiotarsus  
L 90.3mm; g.b. dist. 8.6mm; dist. depth 8.0mm  
Though the blackcock is extinct in East Anglia today it was found  
there until the nineteenth century.

Haddock (Melanogrammus aeglefinus)  
Percaudal vertebra.  
Probably the same fish as 819840

cf. Cod (Gadus morhua)  
Caudal vertebra.

Phalanx 1 rear

Left carpometacarpus, incomplete.  
L 85.9mm

Left tibiotarsus, distal end.  
Dist. b. 11.6mm; dist d. 11.4mm

Domestic fowl (Gallus sp. domestic)  
Right tibiotarsus, fragment of proximal end.
