BLACK-BURNISHED POTTERY FROM STAINES

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Dorset BB1 sherds: Bags 25, 26A; 26B; 27 and sherds 05361, 05362, 05363, 05365, 05366, 05367, 05368, 05369.

The fabric of the above material appears identical in the hand-specimen to BB1 pottery shown to have been made in the Wareham-Poole Harbour area of Dorset (Williams, 1977). A similar origin seems likely for the Staines sherds. The forms present are bead-rimmed dish or bowl (G.316 or G.318) (05365, 05366, 05367, 05368, 05369), plain-rimmed dish (G.329) (Gp.27), bead-rimmed cooking pot (Mumrills fig.11, no.3 or G.118) (05361, 05362, 05363), and bead-rimmed beaker (Mumrills, fig.11, no.1) (Y137).
