Quartzite Pebble

Grey quartzite pebble of uncertain origin, but possibly fairly local.

T2 C8459 (03) Item 873 (NB. Probably not a honestone but a piece of masonry)

These are probably Tertiary in date and of a local origin.

Shelly Limestone

Jurassic origin, probably from Purbeck.
