ALDEBOROUGH - HELICON PAVEMENT

The bones were in good condition although they were all rather fragmentary. The parts of the body represented were skull, including the maxilla; scapula, vertebrae, ribs, pelvis, and bones from the arm and hand. No leg bones were present. The bones were probably all part of the same individual, an adult aged 17-25.

Included with the human bones were a number of fragments of animal bone from a variety of species and one (?) tessera.
