755942			<p>The animal bone consisted of 28 fragments of Red Deer (<u>Cervus elaphus</u>) antler and the proximal end of a metatarsam from the right limb of an Ox (<u>Bos sp.</u>).</p> <p>None of the antler fragments show any signs of wear which could not have been attributed to natural causes. However one tine does show chopping marks close to its distal end, perhaps indicating removal for use as a raw material.
