This collection was very small and rather unusual. It comprised fifteen fallow deer antlers, fourteen of which ~~xxx~~ were cast and one from a dead animal, a horse tooth, some fragments of egg shell of thickness and colour identical to that of a modern hen and two bird bones, one of a rook or crow, the other of a domestic fowl.
