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## Nature of Request

*English Heritage was notified by the London Borough of Haringey of the plight of this building. Listed grade II as recently as 1996, the building has been vacant for a considerable period and is now currently being marketed. The structure has been subject to vandalism and theft and has been placed on the BAR register.*

*Due to concern about the risk of loss or damage to the important features from theft and vandalism, a Schedule of Urgent Works was served on the local authority. The Borough's principal planning officer asked for assistance with the preparation of a record of the building and information regarding its historical development. The structure was built as the offices of the Tottenham School Board at the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. It also provided facilities for teacher training.*

*Following discussions with the local authority, London Region, N&E Area Team, sought advice from HR&CS (London) with regards to an assessment of the surviving fabric of the building. This was to determine the level of record that currently exists for the structure, what level of recording of the surviving fixtures and fittings could be undertaken and what may need to be done for the rest of the building. In agreement with the LB Haringey, HR&CS (London & SE) team offered, in conjunction with the local authority, to assist with a survey and preparation of an inventory of features at the above.*

*This brief report comprises a short description and a detailed inventory of fixtures and fittings. This is based upon site observation following a single visit, limited examination and review of cartographic and other historic sources and an assessment of the extent, character and significance of fabric of either architectural or historical interest. A detailed history of the fabric of this structure is made complicated by alterations, which have occurred as the structure has historically evolved and the lack of conclusive documentary evidence. Only surfaces exposed on the day were recorded and examined and no disturbance to the fabric was undertaken.*

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## **Background**

The Education Offices of Downhills School stand on north side of Philip Lane, at its junction with West Green Road, N15 and opposite a small park, on an island at the intersection of these roads and Spur Road. Ordnance survey national grid reference to the approximate centre of the site: TQ 326893. The building is described on the statutory list as being constructed in 1899-1900, and almost certainly designed by Albert E Pridmore, then architect to the Tottenham School Board. It was one of the most influential examples of Board school architecture of its time. The building has had few alterations over time, to provide improved accommodation and additional facilities and retains many original features. The structure has been left vacant for some considerable time.

The site is not known to have been the subject of any previous major historical assessment, archaeological investigation or building recording survey. There is a reference to the school building within the Victoria County History, Middlesex, vol.RV, 1976.T, but little in other works on the architecture of London.

What appear to be the original drawings have been located and it seems likely that the design is the work of the School Board's architect Albert E. Pridmore. Considerable effort was put into the construction of the building. There is terracotta ornament of good quality outside and internally ornamental glazed tiling to the dado areas as well as handsome chimney pieces (particularly in the Boardroom located behind the three large windows on the first floor) and an elegant iron stair. The building has considerable public character and faces a green. The style is highly eclectic and shows the influence of London School Board.

Any future planning permission will be conditional, in line with central and local government policies (PPG15, PPG16 and LB Haringey Unitary Development Plan), on the implementation of a programme of building recording and fabric analysis, in advance of (and during) any works of alteration. Details of the programme should be summarised within a specification to be submitted to the LB Haringey for approval.

## **Brief Historical Outline**

The first Tottenham School Board met in 1879 at hired offices in Coombes Croft. Its responsibilities were restricted to the ancient parish (nearby Wood Green had its own Board). The 1879 Board planned ten new schools, and the first in this ambitious scheme was that in Coleraine Park, which opened in 1881. Within the decade the Board had provided 5,000 new school places. The greatest jump in provision came two years later, in 1893, with the completion of the Downhills Park School. Designed to accommodate 1,500 students it was the Board's largest work to date, and this site remained the focus for expansion. By 1913 (a decade after the Board met for the last time) Downhills School was the largest in Tottenham, with 2,290 places.

At the start it had been a mixed facility, but by 1913 Downhills School was given over entirely to juniors under the terms of the 1902 Education Act. The school featured in a larger local authority recreation scheme, Downhills Recreation Ground, which was cleared completely for local use by Tottenham Urban District Council in 1902.

The wisdom of excluding Tottenham from the London School Board had always been questioned. In 1895 there were particularly strong calls for the LSB to assume control of the Tottenham Board on the grounds that most of the parents whose children were served " by the Board actually worked in the City. In its defence the Tottenham Board argued that it could provide places more cheaply than the LSB, whose resources were being stretched in the late 1890s. This argument won the day, at least for a time, and the decision to build a large, prominently sited and lavish building to house the offices of the Board (and to serve as a teacher training centre) should be seen as a gesture of defiance, an assertion of local authority power against the rising tide of centralisation. It would prove a short lived triumph. Within two years of the completion of the its ambitious headquarters its business was wound up. Nevertheless, by any standards the

TSB had been a success: 15 schools in 23 years of service, several had more than 1,500 pupils, and the first school for deaf children in Greater London. In 1903 Tottenham and Wood Green became .. separate Part III authorities under the 1902 Education Act. The new Education Commission continued the Tottenham Board's programmes and between 1906 and 1912 provided a further seven schools.

### **Brief Description**

Although early buildings by the Board are rather plain and large, from the late 1890s more ornament began to appear, displaying the Board's growing confidence at this time. Rather poor quality copies of what appear to be the original drawings have been located and it seems likely that the design is the work of the School Board's architect Albert E. Pridmore. It is clear from the surviving structure that considerable effort was put into its construction.

The building is imposing and ostentatious, with rich, flagrant terra-cotta ornament of good quality externally. Internally, there is lavish ornamental glazed tiling to the dado areas as well as handsome chimney pieces internally (particularly in the Boardroom located behind the three large windows on the first floor) and an elegant iron stair.

### **Fixtures and Fittings**

The building retains a number of original fixtures and fittings of interest including elaborate sanitary ware, a mechanical fresh air-circulation system serving the Board Room and a system of internal speaking tubes for communication between the Board and other principal rooms.

The fresh air ventilation system installed was a new innovative type, which used the venturi effect to assist in extracting air. This passive ventilation system was installed within the roof space, and used centrally sited rising air ducts to induce air from the perimeter extract ducts. Grilles in the ceiling sited along the centre line of the Board Room allowed the warm air rising from the room and from gas lighting to pass through and be collected by the hoods in the roof space sited above the ceiling grilles and ventilated in the roof lantern. To compensate for and balance the amount of extracted air, fresh air inlet boxes (each complete with a flap control damper) are installed in the walls.

All important features have been photographically recorded and identified in the following Inventory.

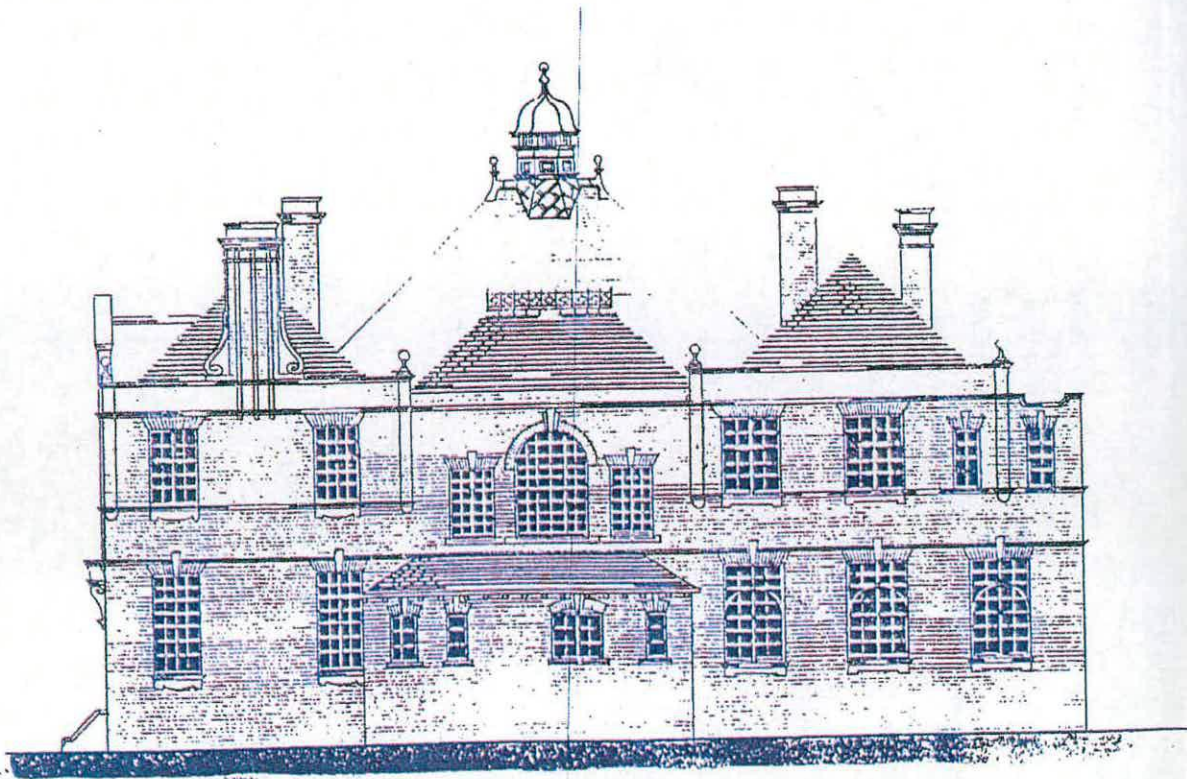

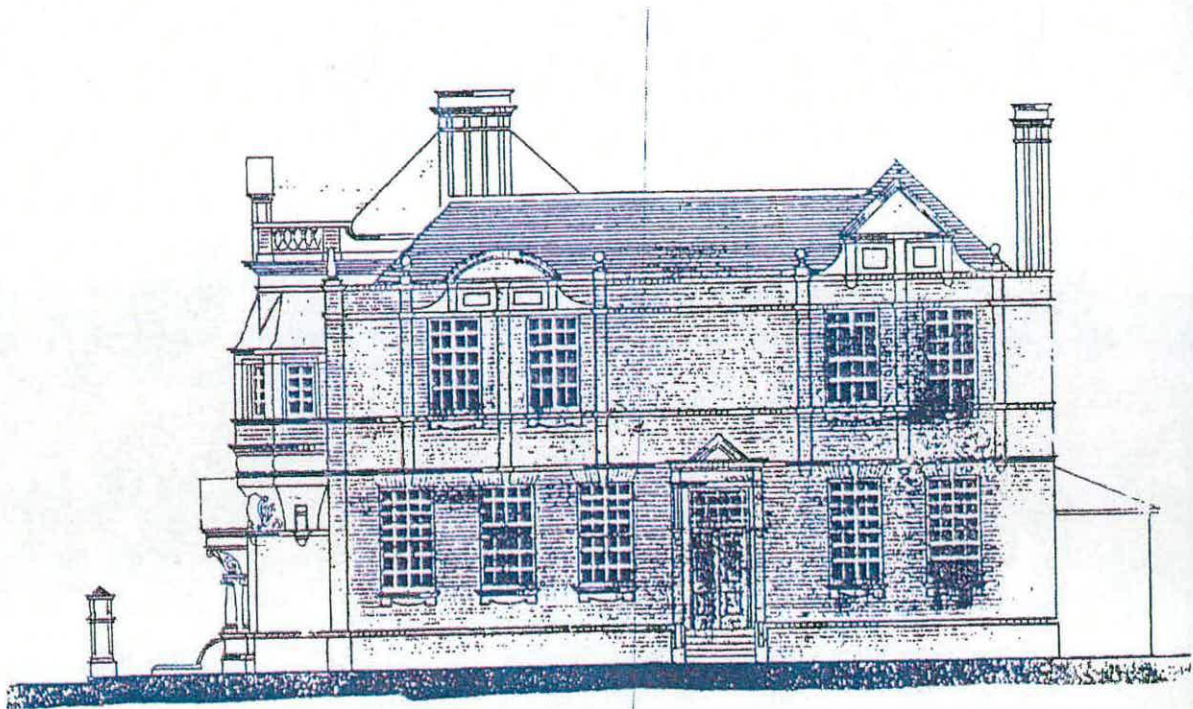

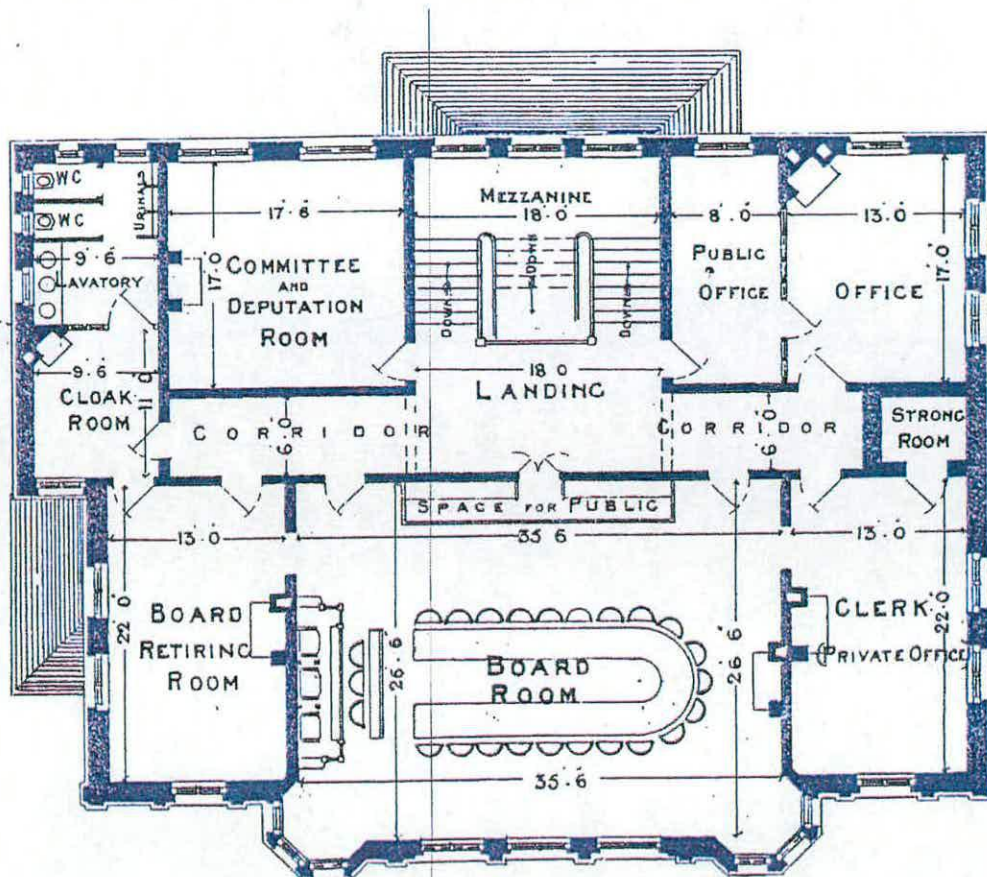

**FIRST FLOOR PLAN**

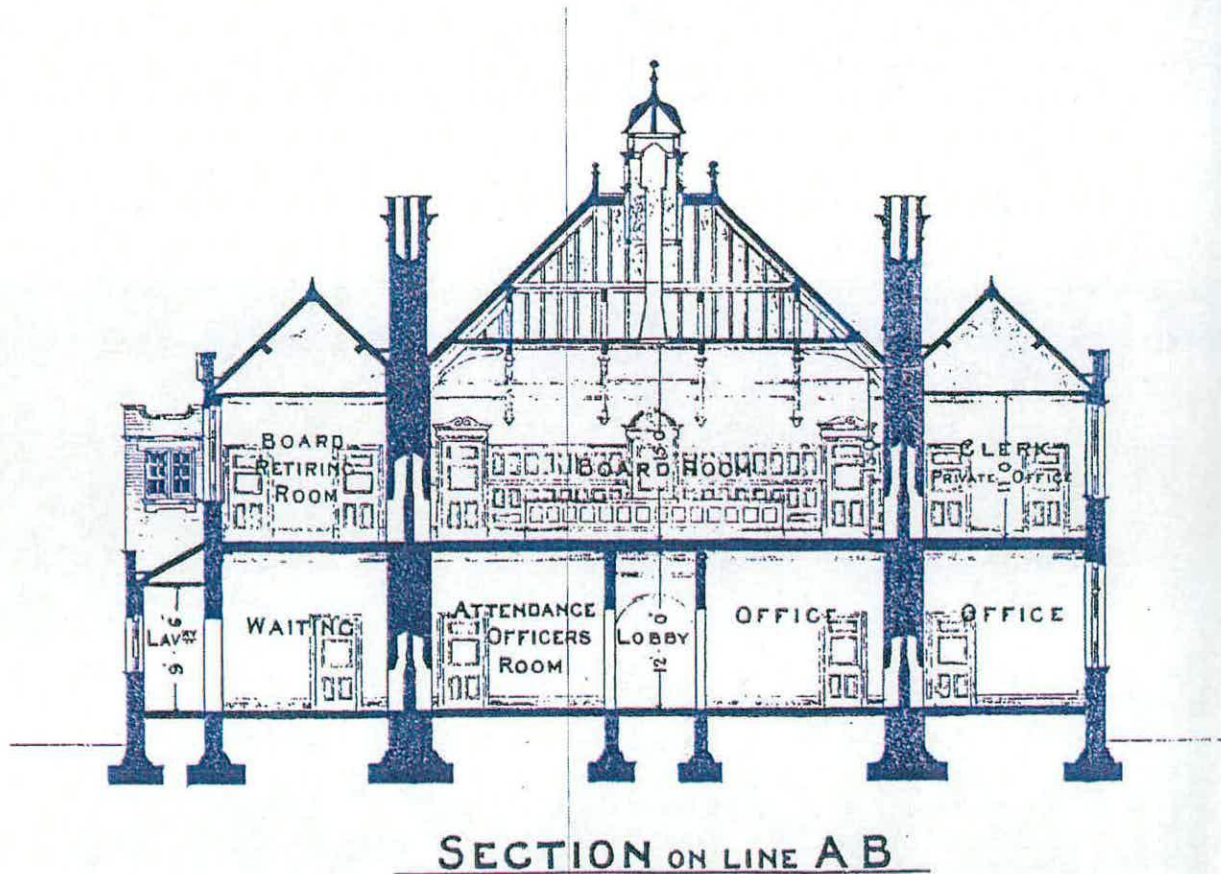

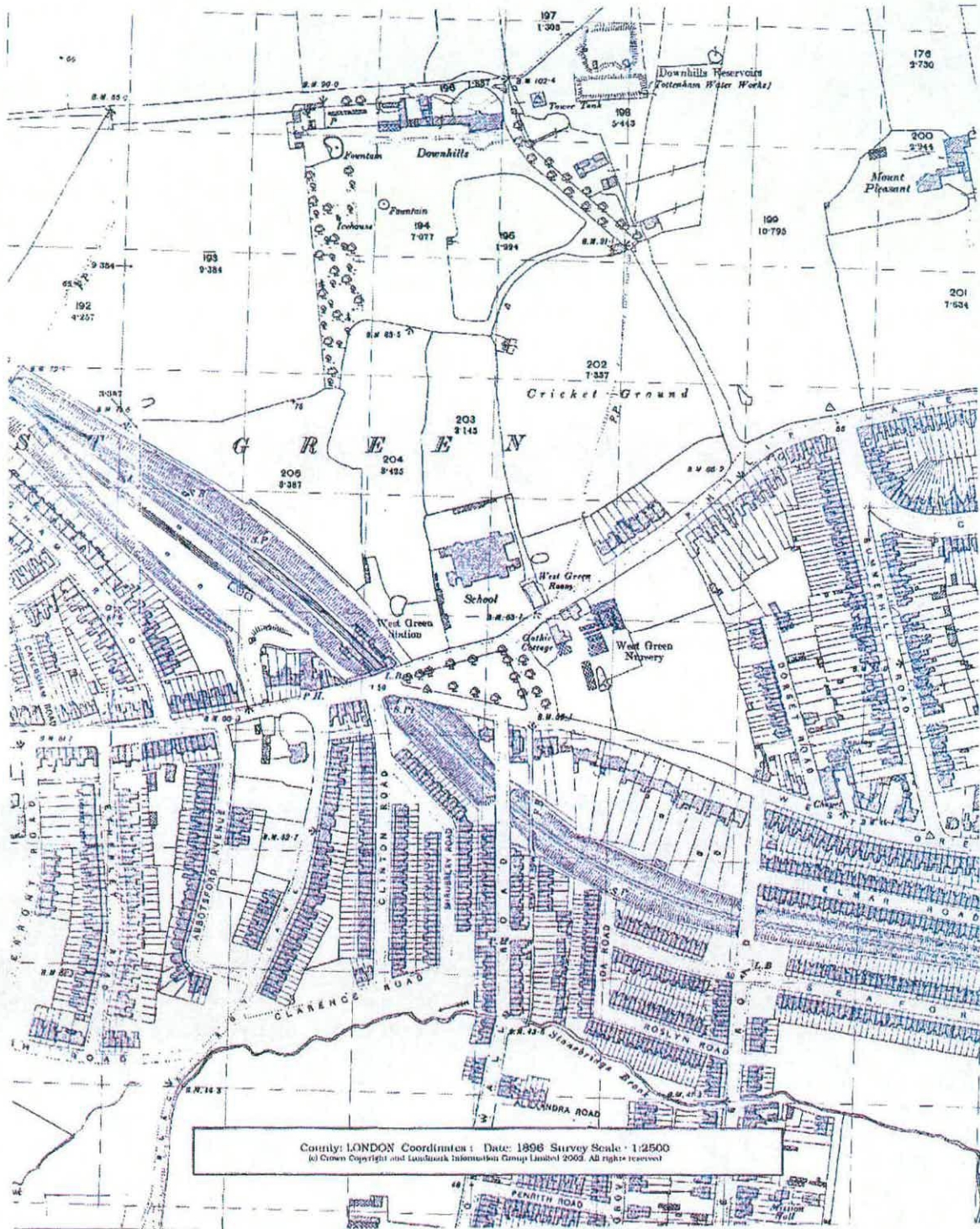


Location Plan

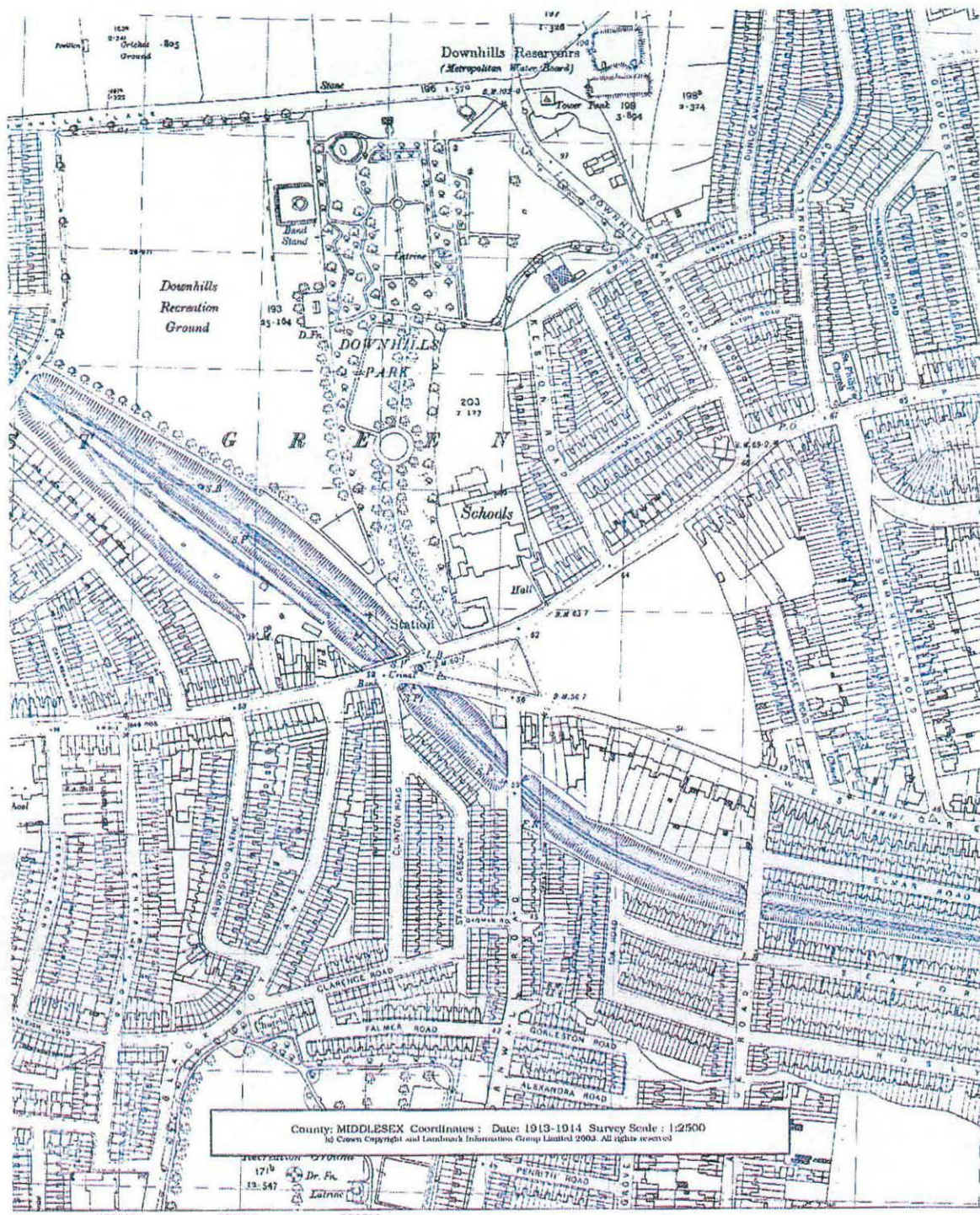
